As part of its development strategy in 2025, the MSIN Group decided to carry out a comprehensive migration of all group companies from SAP ECC to SAP S/4HANA (on-premise). Donit, based in Medvode, was the first company within the Group to successfully complete the migration to SAP S/4HANA.
